### DEFINING BEHAVIORAL HEALTH

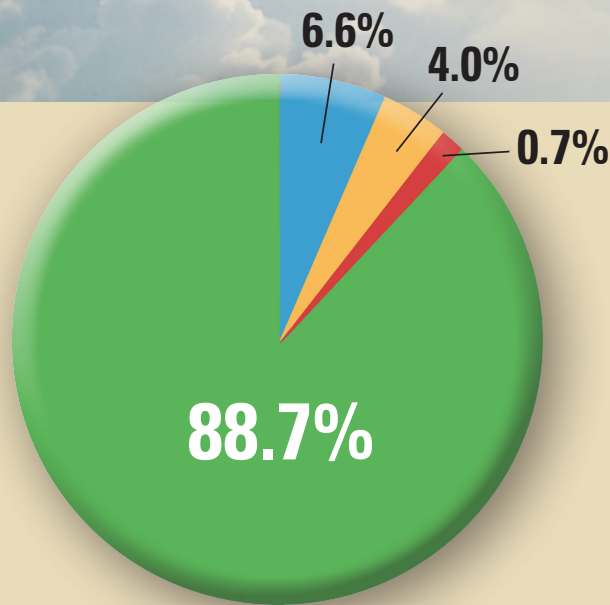
Behavioral health disorders include both mental illness and substance use disorders. Persons with behavioral health care needs may suffer from either or both types of conditions as well as physical comorbidities.

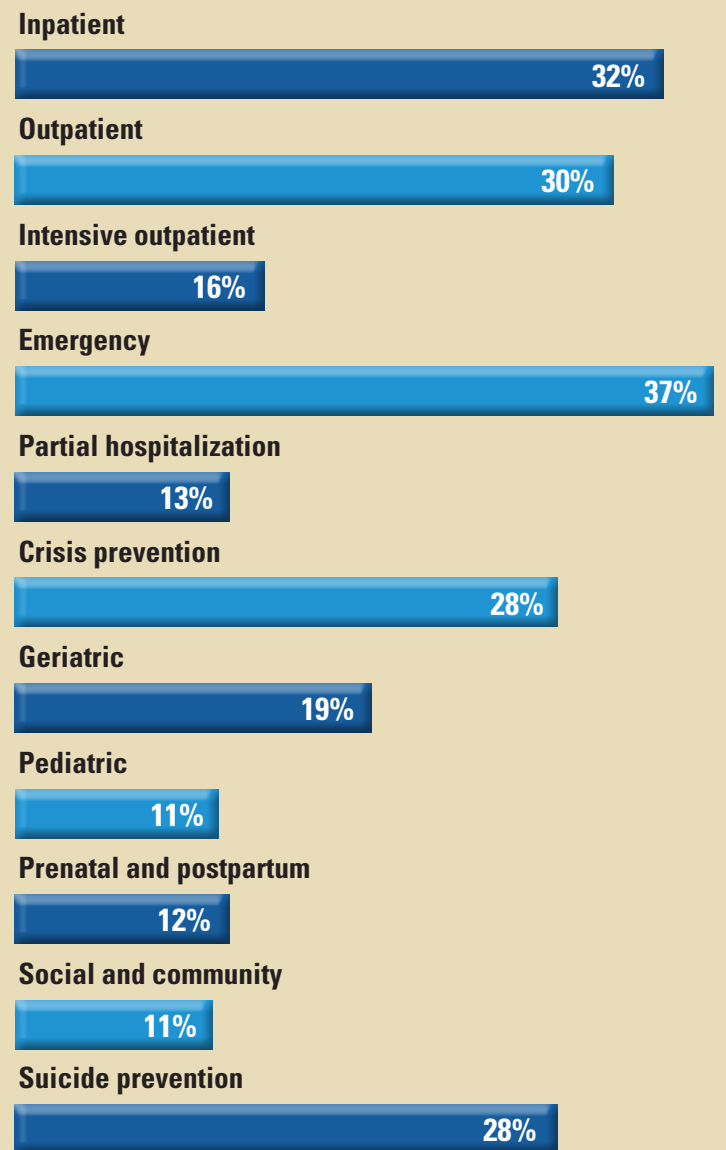
Increase in number of behavioral health hospitals since 2017

- Intellectual disabilities (N=5)

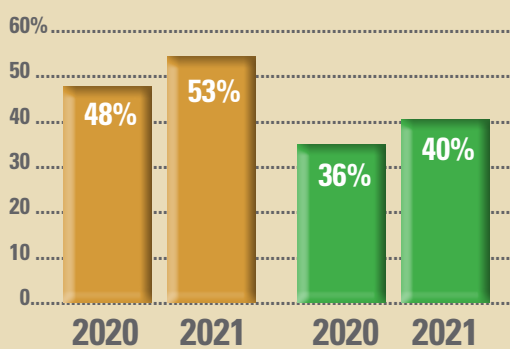
### Community hospitals also provide a variety of psychiatric health services, 2021



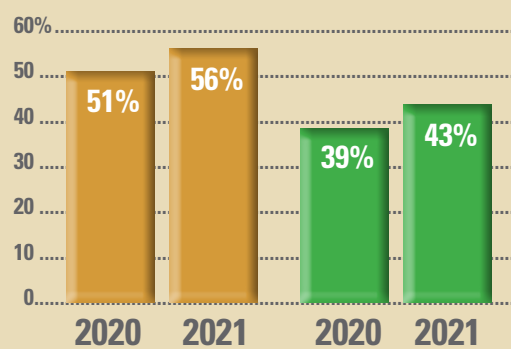
### Behavioral health consultation/liaison services growing

- Substance use disorder consultation/liaison services

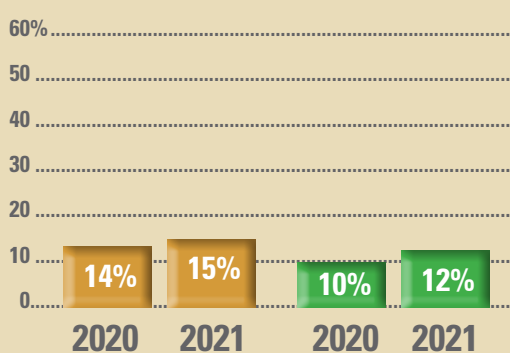

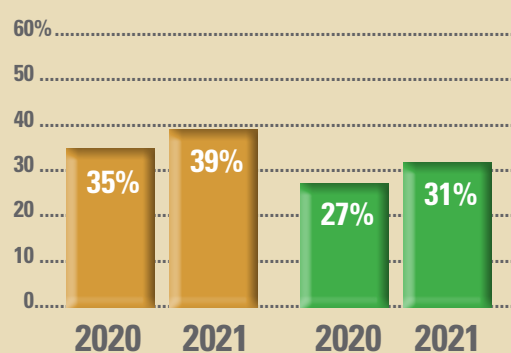
