

Special HHS Conference Call October 9 on Preparing your Hospital or Health Care System for Ebola

The Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) will host a conference call Thursday, Oct. 9, for U.S. hospital leaders on preparing health care systems to protect health and safety should an Ebola patient present at their facility. The call will take place from 4-5 p.m. ET, and instructions for hospital leaders who want to participate in the call are included below.
