Reaching community members with undetected and untreated mental disorders has never been more important. Studies have shown that over 90% of people who die by suicide had one or more psychiatric disorders at the time and never received treatment.

National Depression Screening Day provides mental health screening for those not in treatment plus suicide detection and education for friends, families and clinicians. NDSD helps to:

- Reach community members across the lifecycle, year-round
- Market your services to community members
- Educate clinicians and hospitals on how to provide suicide risk assessment in compliance with the new safety goals on suicide (JCAHO)



All suicidal people need a helping hand. Empower your community and clinicians to recognize the signs of suicide and how to respond.

## **Targeting**

- Community: Mental health screening for four prevalent mental illnesses: depression, bipolar disorder, generalized anxiety disorder, and posttraumatic stress disorder (PTSD)
- Friends and Family: Education about signs of suicide and how to respond
- Clinicians and Hospitals: Suicide risk assessment tools including resources to meet JCAHO 2007 Patient Safety Goals

Participating organizations have the option of providing year-round, anonymous online screening

## **In-Person Screening Events**

NDSD is implemented at the community level by health care, social service, government, faith-based, and advocacy organizations.

#### The NDSD office provides:

- A comprehensive kit of ready-to-use materials
- · Event promotion materials and guidelines/templates
- A national media campaign to increase attendance at events
- Support and technical assistance via phone, email and the web

## Organizations conducting a screening event provide:

- · Clinicians and administrative staff to run the event
- Physical location for the event (A high-visibility community location)
- Event promotion and implementation in your local community

# Online Screening - 24/7 Through Your Website (\$195)

Anonymous, online screening for depression, bipolar disorder, generalized anxiety disorder and PTSD with immediate results and feedback. Your community members will receive a customized welcome message and referral for evaluation and/or treatment. Real-time utilization reports of screening results. Plus, add your own customized demographic questions. Available in both English and Spanish.

#### Older Adult Kit (\$95)

The Older Adult Kit includes education and screening materials for 25 older adult participants, including educational brochures addressing depression and suicide risk in later life, Suicide Risk Questionaire, and a Feel Good Bingo<sup>®</sup> game that educates older adults about depression, anxiety disorders and suicide.

New this year: A Clinician Guide for Geriatric Depression and Suicidality in Primary Care to help clinicians identify and treat depression and suicide risk in older adults.

# Mini Kit (\$95)

For organizations that plan to host a smaller event, the Mini Kit provides enough materials to screen and educate 25 participants, including screening forms, brochures, posters and the Implementation and Promotion Guide. This kit does not include a video.
