President Obama proposed reducing payments to rehabilitation hospitals and units by more than \$10 billion over 10 years, despite inpatient rehabilitation's success in providing high quality care at a flat cost curve. These reductions would reduce patients' access to intensive rehabilitation provided by rehabilitation hospitals.
