HHS WEBINARS OCT. 20 AND OCT. 22 ON COVID-19 DATA REPORTING

HHS' Office of Intergovernmental Affairs Oct. 20 and Oct. 22 will host webinars on which administration officials will discuss the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services' interpretative guidance on how it will implement an interim final rule that makes collecting and reporting COVID-19 data a condition of participation for hospitals that participate in Medicare. The guidance, which was released earlier this month, includes new reporting requirements for hospitals, as well as enforcement provisions.
