CISA Urges Implementation of Cybersecurity Measures to Protect Against Potential Critical Threats

On January 18, 2022, the Cybersecurity and Infrastructure Security Agency (CISA) released a CISA Insights report in response to recent malicious cyber incidents in Ukraine including the defacement of government websites and the presence of potentially destructive malware on Ukrainian systems. The CISA Insights distribution strongly urges leaders and network defenders to be on alert for malicious cyber activity and provides a checklist of concrete actions that every organization, regardless of sector or size, can action immediately.
